**HAITI UPDATE... January 13/10 from Dan Sheffield**

I am sure that most of us have been following information about the massive earthquake in Haiti. Also I am sure that many of you are aware the FMC has had a long history of ministry in Haiti. Our family there includes almost 80 churches with a membership of close to 15,000. **ICCM**, our childcare sponsorship program, sponsors 4000 children through 53 school-based programs around the country.

At present there are also 19 American FM missionaries or short-term workers in Haiti. We have just received word that a mission building in Port au Prince collapsed in the quake with a number of our workers in the building. Jeanne Munos, Merle West, Gene Dufor and a Haitien staff member Erlin are presently unaccounted for in that building. Jack Munos and Katie Zook were pulled from the building with non-life-threatening injuries. All other personnel are accounted for.

In an emergency situation like this, the FM Church does not have trained emergency response teams – *we work with organizations that do.* Our primary partner in this regard is **World Relief Canada.** We would encourage any emergency funds to be sent to them directly to minimize time delays. Keep posted at their site for updates on their plans. ⇨

## **HAITI UPDATE Continued...**

But the real challenge in a situation like this is the medium-term response – the next couple of months, when civil infrastructure, presently almost non-existent, will be severely stretched. Things like shelter while homes are being rebuilt; food and safe water, trauma counseling, etc. These are the kinds of things that our churches on the ground do well! In past natural disasters in Haiti, the distribution system through our churches has proved to be a significant aid. We are able to work directly through our leadership infrastructure on the ground and to transfer funds to the places where the need is greatest. At present the quake seems localized to Port au Prince, but it would be normal for many people to return to family in rural areas while they await the rebuilding process; in the weeks to come rural churches may find themselves serving many displaced persons from PaP. The two mechanisms that we have for getting funds to our family in Haiti for help in the weeks to come are the **Bishop's Relief Fund** and ICCM.

### **As of January 14, 2010... from Lynda Stryker**

We are praising the Lord for news just received from Bishop David Roller who had talked with Dr Dan Snyder just a short time ago.

Today Dan saw ICCM/Haiti field coordinator, Perkins Mondale whose wife is also alive but has some injuries. Supt Devariste Supt, who is also the local pastor of the church near the ICCM office, is in the hospital with a broken leg.

The ICCM building and other FM buildings are still standing. The only FM building in that area that totally collapsed is the FOHO building.

This afternoon Jack Munos and Katie Zook, who are now in Miami, seemed to have made a turn for the better. They were awake, alert and talking to people.

More news direct from Haiti is expected tomorrow. Andy Yardy, who was authorized by Bishop Roller to go to Haiti to get specific information about our brothers and sisters in Haiti, is in the Dominican Republic near the border with Haiti and will continue his trip to Port au Prince in the morning. His trip has been challenging. He left Indy for Haiti as soon as possible--about 12 hrs after the first earthquake hit. He has water, water filters and medicines with him.
